

## IRREGULAR PLURAL NOUNS

### A. Cases of allomorphy of the root morpheme

1. Vowel change in the root → the plural form is an allomorph of the root morpheme in the singular:

**Foot – feet**  
**Goose – geese**  
**Louse – lice**  
**Man – men**  
**Woman - women**  
**Mouse – mice**  
**Tooth – teeth**

2. Voiceless fricative in the singular → voiced fricative in the plural (the plural form is an allomorph of the root morpheme in the singular) + the regular suffix:

**Calf – calves**  
**Elf – elves**  
**Half – halves**  
**Knife – knives**  
**Life – lives**  
**Loaf – loaves**  
**Self – selves**  
**Sheaf – sheaves**  
**Shelf – shelves**  
**Thief – thieves**  
**Wife – wives**  
**Wolf - wolves**

### B. Suffixes

3. Zero-allomorph of the plural suffix –s:

**Aircraft – aircraft** \_

**Bison** – bison             
**Deer** – deer             
**Grouse** – grouse             
**Sheep** – sheep             
**Species** – species             
**Swine** – swine             
**Trout** – trout             
**Tuna** – tuna           

**4. Suffix -(r)en:**

**Brother** - breth**ren**  
**Child** – child**ren**  
**Ox** – ox**en**

**5. Suffix –a:**

**Addendum** – addend**a**  
**Bacterium** – bacter**ia**  
**Corpus** – corpor**a**  
**Criterion** – criter**ia**  
**Curriculum** – curricul**a**  
**Datum** – data  
**Erratum** – errata  
**Genus** – genera  
**Medium** – media  
**Phenomenon** - phenom**ena**  
**Stratum** – strata

**6. Suffix –i (pronounced as [aɪ] or [i:]):**

<b>Alumnus</b> – alumni	[ə'lʌmnəs] - [ə'lʌmnai]/ [ə'lʌmni:]
<b>Bacillus</b> – bacilli	[bə'siləs] - [bə'silai]/ [bə'sili:]
<b>Cactus</b> – cacti (also cactuses)	
<b>Focus</b> – foci	[ˈfəukəs] - ['fəusai]/ ['fəukai]/ ['fəusi:]
<b>Fungus</b> – fungi	[ˈfʌŋgəs] - ['fʌŋgi:/]/ ['fʌŋgai]
<b>Locus</b> – loci	[ˈləukəs] - ['ləusai]/ ['ləukai]

**Nucleus – nuclei** ['nju:kliəs] - ['nju:kliəɪ]/ ['nju:kliɪ:]  
**Stimulus – stimuli**  
**Syllabus – syllabi** (also syllabuses)

**7. Suffix –ae (pronounced as [aɪ] or [i:]):**

**Alga – algae** ['ælgə] - ['ældʒɪ:]  
**Alumna – alumnae**  
**Formula – formulae**  
**Larva – larvae**  
**Nebula – nebulae**

**8. Suffix –es [i:z] typical for words of Greek origin ending in -is:**

**Analysis – analyses**  
**Axis – axes**  
**Basis – bases**  
**Crisis – crises**  
**Diagnosis – diagnoses**  
**Ellipsis – ellipses**  
**Oasis – oases**  
**Parenthesis -parentheses**  
**Prognosis – prognoses**  
**Thesis – theses**
