Course Objectives: The main objectives of this course are:

To prepare students for academic writing through approaching writing as a process of planning, outlining, drafting, revising and writing the final draft

- To develop learners' reading and writing strategies so as to enhance their reading and writing performance.
- To help learners deal with Reading and writing difficulties.
- To help learners reflect on their progress as readers and set goals for themselves.
- To help learners write well-structured paragraphs and evaluate their own and others' writing

Expected Learning Outcomes of the first semeter:

By the end of the first semester (S1), learners should be able to:

- **1.** Write different types of sentences (simple, compound, complex).
- **2.** Understand, describe and use the different steps of the writing process (Prewriting, Drafting, Revising, Editing, Publishing and sharing)
